- 1916 Annual Town Report: William Edmunds owns a dwelling on Croton Street (\$10,275) [29 Croton Street], 13,550 sq. ft. of land (\$1000), and 13,550 sq. ft. of land (\$1000). Helen F. [sic] Eastman owns a dwelling on Croton Street (\$8500) [32 Croton Street], 7047 sq. ft. of land (\$700), and 13,054 sq. ft. of land (\$1300).
- 1917 Annual Town Report: William Edmunds owns a house at 29 Croton Street (\$10,275) and 29,000 sq. ft. of land (\$2900). Helen S. Eastman owns a house on Croton Street (\$8500) [32 Croton Street], 20,101 sq. ft. of land (\$2000), a house on Pine Street (\$5500) [32 Pine Street], and 12,550 sq. ft. of land (\$1250).
- Mortgage for \$6000 given by William Edmunds to John Edmunds & Francis H. Hersey (Trustees for "The Seven Associates") on September 11, 1916.
- Given sale of house in mid-January 1917, the year of construction is determined to be 1916.
- Note: The building permit listed under 32 Pine Street is actually for the construction of the dwelling at 32 Croton Street in 1915.
