MINUTES OF WELLESLEY HISTORICAL COMMISSION MEETING ON OCTOBER 29, 2013

- 1. Wright called the meeting to order at 10:08am.
- 2. Minutes: It was **moved** by Fergusson, **seconded** by Robertson, and **passed unanimously** to postpone the consideration of the minutes until the next meeting.
- 3. Cochituate Aqueduct: Wright gave a brief description of and explanation for the proposed conveyance of a state-owned parcel of the Cochituate Aqueduct to the owner of the Dunkin' Donuts on the westbound side of Worcester Street. He also made note of a state law that any conveyance of state-owned land is subject to a review by the Massachusetts Historical Commission to determine whether the proposed development on the parcel would be detrimental to any historical structures. There was discussion among the WHC members about whether the WHC is obligated to provide notice to the MHC at this stage. It was **moved** by Fergusson, **seconded** by Lueth, and **passed unanimously** to get in touch with Town Council to clarify the obligation of the WHC regarding the conveyance of state-owned property.
